

Lesson Plans - French 4

Monday 31 March

TLW :

Recall how to form the passé composé and the imparfait tenses in French through writing.

PLAN :

Students will spend 15-20 minutes writing a short paragraph about an event, real or imagined, that happened to them when they were younger. The student will employ both the imperfect and the passé composé tenses in this writing.

Students will then review how to properly form the tenses and when to use each one, and proceed to correct any errors in their paragraphs.

HOMWORK:

Paragraphs are due tomorrow.

TLW :

Recall formation and use of passé composé and imparfait in terms of deciding which form is appropriate in a certain situation.

PLAN:

Students will switch present tense sentences into the imperfect on the board.

Students will work in Ch. 4 Packets on various activities practicing using the imperfect and the passé composé and deciding which is appropriate where.

TLW:

Students will demonstrate mastery of imperfect and passé composé by completing a short quiz. Students will then review formation of future and conditional tenses in writing.

PLAN:

Students will conjugate verbs written on the board into the future and conditional tenses and describe the differences between the two tenses.

Students will spend first part of the period writing a short text.

Topic: Pretend you have won 250 million dollars in the lottery. Write a short story about what you will do with all of your new money. Make sure you use the future tense.

Once writing is completed, students will go over their writing with teacher and then have the chance to correct mistakes.
