Monday April 7th

TLW:

Begin study of the simple future tense.

PLAN:

From memory, come up with at least 10 verbs that have to do with cooking and preparing food.
Write the verbs in the infinitive (don't conjugate them)

- The student will be introduced to the formation of the future tense.
- The students will conjugate the four irregular verbs in the future tense (faire, aller, avoir, être)
- Discuss the difference between the future tense and the aller + infinitive tense.

HOMEWORK:

Write 10 things (sentences) that you will do this summer.

Tuesday April 8th

TLW:

Learn how to say what they have others do for them.

PLAN:

The student will rewrite a paragraph written on the board correcting the mistakes found in it.

- Discuss when we use faire + infinitive
- The students will brainstorm things that we can have others do for us.
- Complete ex. 22 on p. 188 as a class or in partners.
- Ex. 24 as a class on p. 189

TLW:

Listen to an authentic conversation and respond to comprehension questions. The learner will also complete audio and video activities for Ch. 6

PLAN:

Some practice quiz questions will be on the board as a warm-up for students to complete.

- Student will listen to conversation with the book closed (2x)
- Student and partner will read conversation together on p. 190
- Student will listen to conversation again while reading along.
- Answer comprehension questions as a class.
- Student will look at photo on p. 191 and with a partner come up with 5 different things that are going on in the picture. Students may be asked to give oral description aloud to the class.
- Students will complete audio activities for Ch. 6
- Students will watch a short video clip and respond to questions on a worksheet about the video.
- Mind Jogger game-show if time.
- Students will discuss project for next week. Students must choose a creative project demonstrating knowledge of vocabulary and concepts in this chapter.
